After the untimely death of USSF National Assessor Larry McManus of Pensacola in 1991, the league championship was renamed the "McManus Cup" and the next 5 consecutive years was appointed to referee the League Final.

1988-1994 was Assistant Referee in the American Professional Soccer League (APSL). The league closed in 1994 to prepare for the MLS in 1996.

1980-1996 refereed a total of 378 adult games both domestic and international exhibitions either as referee or assistant referee.
